Mine Technician

Reporting to the Technical Services Superintendent, the Mine Technician carries out daily and weekly mine planning process, production performance measurement, cost controls and consumables inventory. The Mine Technician provides engineering production and driving layouts for the short and long-term mine plan and assists in the scheduling and drafting of different mine plans and infrastructure systems.

Candidate must be organized, have strong computer skills, be a quick learner, have sound judgement and be able to handle a demanding and variable work load.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

The successful candidate will be responsible for:

- Performing underground surveying using Total Station and CMS;
- Performing ventilation surveys as required by legislation;
- Issuing detailed development driving layouts to the mine;
- Designing drill and blast plans for longhole stoping.
- Tracings daily, weekly & monthly production metrics;
- Designing and monitor mine infrastructure including ventilation, dewatering and backfill systems and measures;
- Performing quality control ground support pull tests, pin line measurement and prism surveys and ensure the Ground Control Management Plan is adhered to on plans;
- Analyzing and making recommendations on ways to improve mine operating performance and works cooperatively with the mining contractor and entire team to implement best practices and continuous improvement;
- Demonstrating awareness and commitment to health, community and environmental protection and acts to ensure that unsafe practices or non-compliant behaviours do not occur;
- Monitoring and sampling site process and non-process water and compiling applicable reports;
- Performing other related duties as required.

REQUIREMENTS OF THE POSITION:

- College or university degree in a Mining related discipline
- 3-5 years experience at an operating mine. Underground experience is an asset.
- Eligible for registration with EGBC or ASTTBC
- Experience with Promine is an asset

- Be technically competent and have a good understanding of key business drivers for underground mining.
- Able to effectively create strategic relationships with engineering, operations and management personnel.
- Have strong communication and people skills.
