LAB TECHNICIAN – QR Mill Assay Lab

Reporting to the Chief Assayer or their Designate, the Lab Technician will be responsible for the safe, efficient, reliable, and accurate handling and preparation of all samples submitted to the Assay Lab. The incumbent must possess good communication skills, be self-motivated, and well organized while continuously aligning daily functions to reflect Barkerville Gold Mines Ltd. values.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

The successful candidate will:

- Ensure adherence to laboratory policies & procedures;
- Collecting & preparing samples for analysis;
- Reporting accurate sample analysis results in a timely manner;
- Ensuring weekly panel production targets are met;
- Implementing new technology as available;
- Ensuring that all employees work safely and in accordance with applicable legislation, company policy, standards, and procedures;
- Reporting hazards & incidents in a timely manner, in line with BGM reporting procedures;
- Prepare daily shift reports on Standard forms, record equipment failures, etc;
- Keep daily log of shift events;
- Perform other duties as assigned.
